Pilgrim Hall Museum's April Kids Week

Each spring, Pilgrim Hall Museum presents natural history programs for with a very series of April Kids Week programming. Monday, April 21 through Thursday, April 24, the Museum will present daily afternoon nature programs—with LIVE animals! Kids Week is fun for the whole family—kids, parents and grandparents. Children are admitted FREE all day long.

Presenters include staff from the Thornton W. Burgess Society, a non-profit organization dedicated to furthering the author's efforts to promote wildlife conservation and love of nature, and also the staff from the Soule Homestead, a non-profit farm and agricultural education center.

The programs run Monday-Thursday from 2 to 3 pm as follows:

April 21, "Animal Magic Variety Show," Stephen Brenner

April 22, "Frogs and Toads," Mary Beers, Thornton Burgess Society

April 23, "Meet the Animals," Laurie Amberman, Soule Homestead

In addition, Treasure Hunts will be available all day, enabling children to explore Pilgrim Hall Museum's permanent exhibitions which include artifacts that belonged to the Pilgrim settlers.

Children under 18 are admitted free all day (must be accompanied by an adult). Admission is \$8 for adults, \$7 for seniors. Admission is free for members of Pilgrim Hall Museum and for Plymouth residents. Free parking is available in the Museum lot.
